Declaration of a State of Emergency by the Schenectady County Manager

WHEREAS, the World Health Organization has declared the COVID-19 virus to be a pandemic;
and

WHEREAS, the President of the United States declared a National State of Emergency related to
the COVID-19 pandemic on March 13, 2020; and

WHEREAS, in my capacity as the Schenectady County Manager, I previously declared a state of
emergency on several occasions pursuant to Section 24 of the New York State Executive Law; and


WHEREAS, the Delta variant of COVID-19 has caused an increase in COVID-19 across the
nation, and in Schenectady County; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rory Fluman, County Manager of the County of Schenectady, by virtue
of the authority vested in me in the Charter of the County of Schenectady and Section 24 of the New
York State Executive Law, to preserve the public safety and to render all appropriate assistance to the
safety, well-being, and health of the residents of this County, I declare that a local state of emergency in
and for the County of Schenectady immediately upon my execution of this declaration; and

Further, this State of Emergency shall remain in full force and effect for thirty (30) calendar days
from the date of its execution, unless rescinded by a subsequent declaration; and


Further, I hereby direct all departments and agencies of the County of Schenectady to take
whatever steps necessary to protect life and property, public infrastructure, and provide emergency
assistance as I shall from time to time direct.
