Notice is hereby given that Schenectady County will accept bids for:

**PIN 1760.60 – Nott Street/Balltown Road Intersection Safety Improvements
Town of Niskayuna, Schenectady County, New York**

The project primarily consists of roadway reconstruction on Nott Street (CR 6) between Clifton Park Road and Balltown Road (NY 146) in the Town of Niskayuna, Schenectady County, NY. Highway work includes full depth reconstruction, mill and overlay, sidewalks and curbs, signs, Rapid Rectangular Flashing Beacons (RRFBs), closed drainage, colored and imprinted concrete, and traffic signal improvements. The parking lot will be reconstructed in front of the Co-Op Plaza, and mid-block curb extensions and mountable curb islands will be installed. Construction shall not commence until on or after March 1, 2022. No ground disturbance or impacts to existing traffic flow or adjacent parking will be allowed prior to March 1, 2022.

Contract will be awarded based upon the lowest qualified bid. Digital Copies of Contract Documents, including Invitation to Bidders, Instructions to Bidders, Wage Rates, Bid Documents, Agreement, Special Notes, Contract Drawings, Specifications and any Addenda Drawings and Specifications may be obtained from BidNet Direct at www.bidnetdirect.com/new-york or by submitting a request to the Purchasing Department at purchasing@schenectadycounty.com. Please specify if printed or copies on USB are required in your request. Please allow 24 hours' notice for paper copies. You will be notified when they are ready for pickup. No questions or inquiries regarding this bid will be accepted after **12:00 PM Local Time June 24, 2021**.

The project funding includes Federal Funding that is subject to a DBE Goal of 6%.

Bids to be considered must be received in a sealed envelope at the Schenectady County Purchasing Department at the County Offices, 620 State Street, 6th Floor, Schenectady, NY 12305 Attn: Jennifer Nelson, until **11:00AM, local time, on June 30, 2021** at which time and place they will be read aloud. Bids received after the above noted time will not be accepted. Bidders shall be advised that they may experience a delay in passing through the building security and shall plan accordingly. All sealed envelopes should be clearly labeled "BID FOR RFB-2021-16 NOTT STREET/BALLTOWN ROAD INTERSECTION SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS." The sealed bids shall include THREE SETS of the completed Bid Form, Non-Collusive Bidding Certification (as required by chapter 956 of the Laws of New York State), and Bid Bond made out to Schenectady County.
